PUBLIC NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Trustee Election for the Lake Delhi Combined Recreational Facility and Water Quality District** in Delaware County, Iowa will be held on **Tuesday, July 17, 2018**. Polls will be open from 12:00 PM (noon) until 8:00 PM. The polling location will be as follows:

**St. John's Parish Hall
303 South Street, Delhi**

Voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before they may receive and cast a ballot. However, pre-registered voters who are unable to show approved ID may sign an oath of identification for an election held in 2018.

Pre-registration, for this election, will close on Friday, July 6, 2018 at 5:00 P.M. It is highly recommended that those persons wishing to vote in this election pre-register on or before the July 6, 2018 deadline. Voters who are not pre-registered or who have changed precincts also may be required to provide proof of residence. The following documents can be used as proof of residency if they are current to within 45 days of submission and contain your name and current address: residential lease, utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check or other government document. Please note that property tax statements CANNOT be used as proof of residence for this election due to the 45 day requirement. Any voter who cannot show ID may have their identity attested to by another registered voter in the precinct who has proper ID. Starting January 1, 2019, all voters will be required to present an approved form of identification. For more information about voter ID, visit <http://sos.iowa.gov/voterid> or call 563-927-4701.

To request an absentee ballot, please use the official form available at the Delaware County Auditor's Office, the county website at www.co.delaware.ia.us or at the Secretary of State's website located at www.sos.state.ia.us and send it to the Delaware County Commissioner of Elections, 301 E. Main St., Room 210, Manchester, Iowa 52057. The last day to request an absentee ballot to be sent by mail is Friday, July 6, 2018 at 5:00 pm. In-person absentee voting is available at the Delaware County Auditor's Office thru 11:00 am on Tuesday, July 17, 2018. The Auditor's Office will be open on Saturday, July 7, 2018 from 9:30 am until 12:00 pm for absentee voting. You may track the progress of your absentee ballot. The link is available on both the County's and Secretary of State's websites.

All polling places designated for use in this election are accessible to persons with disabilities. Any voter who is physically unable to enter a polling place has the right to vote in the voter's vehicle. Voting equipment to be used in this election will be tested and certified on Tuesday, July 10, 2018 at 9:00 am in the Courthouse Basement at 301 East Main Street, Manchester, Iowa. The public is invited to attend.
