The Delaware County Board of Supervisors and ex-officio Board of County Canvassers, for Delaware County, Iowa, met to certify the votes cast in this county at the Regular Municipal Election held on the 3rd day of November, 2009, as shown by the tally lists returned from the election precincts of the cities opting for run-off. Shirley Helmrichs, Chairperson, called the meeting to order at 1:00 P.M. Results of the canvass were as follows:

**Edgewood Corp** – For the office of Mayor, forty-three (43) total votes were cast of which Jim Stone received forty-one (41) votes and Frank Riester received one (1) vote. Jim Stone was declared elected for a term of two (2) years.

For the office of City Council, there were one hundred twenty-five (125) total votes cast of which Bruce Hemann received forty-six (46) votes, Frank Riester received thirty-six (36) votes, Bruce West received forty (40) votes, Art Fudge received one (1) vote and Nicole Bahls received one (1) vote. Bruce Hemann, Frank Riester and Bruce West were declared elected for four (4) year terms.

**Hopkinton Corp** – For the office of Mayor, there were one hundred eight (108) total votes cast of which Cathy Harris received eighty (80) votes, Steve Davis received twelve (12) votes, Dave Klaren received two (2) votes, Judy Tucker received two (2) votes, Randy Less received two (2) votes, John Schaul received two (2) votes, Kyle Wilson received three (3) votes, D J Hucker received one (1) vote, Terry Harbach received one (1) vote, Ron Schuman received one (1) vote, Dan Tucker received one (1) vote and Don Chapman received one (1) vote. Cathy Harris was declared elected for a term of two (2) years.

For the office of City Council, there were two hundred twenty-one (221) total votes cast of which Sarah Helle received sixty-five (65) votes, Robert Ristow received sixty-three (63) votes, Judy Tucker received forty-eight (48) votes and Craig Wilson received forty-five (45) votes. Sarah Helle and Robert Ristow were declared elected for four (4) years terms.

**Manchester Corp** – For the office of Mayor, there were one hundred forty-one (141) total votes cast of which Milt L. Kramer received one hundred twenty-seven (127), Tony Browning received two (2) votes, Jim Schaul received three (3) vote, Jeff Ogden received two (2) vote, Bill Jones received one (1) vote, Phillip Turnis received one (1) vote, Marcel Kielkucki received two (2) votes, Lee Rempe received one (1) vote, Leo Monaghan received one (1) vote and Michael Joseph Peyton received one (1) vote. Milt L. Kramer is declared elected for a term of four (4) years.

For the office of City Council Member – At Large, there were one hundred forty-four (144) total votes cast of which Ron Struble received one hundred thirty-nine (139) votes, Toni Browning received two (2) votes, Terry Folsom received one (1) vote, Tim Cook received one (1) vote and Marcel Kielkucki received one (1) vote. Ron Struble was declared elected for a term of four (4) years.

For the office of City Council Member – Ward 2, there were fifty-seven (57) total votes cast of which Tony Broghammer received fifty-five (55) votes and Ed Poynor received one (1). Tony Broghammer was declared elected for a term of four (4) years.
