



2011 “Discover Nature” Photo Contest

Delaware County Conservation Dept. (DCCD) will be sponsoring a photo contest open to amateur photographers only

Amateur - anyone who does not receive a fee for taking photos

Professional - anyone who receives a fee for taking photos

Professionals will be disqualified

Rules:

1. Color or black & white prints 5x7 or larger will be accepted. Photos are not to be matted or mounted. Each entry must also be submitted on a CD, (to be used by the Conservation Dept.) with name, address, and category affixed to the back.
2. **Photos entered in categories A and B must be taken in Del. Co. Conservation Parks or Wildlife Areas**
Label the back of each photo to indicate where the picture was taken, category, your name, phone number, address.
3. Photos must be taken during the current contest year.
4. Each photo must be entered in one of three categories:
 - A. Nature - (landscape, wildflowers etc)
 - B. People Enjoying Outdoor activities in Del. Co. Cons. Parks or Wildlife Areas
 - C. Wildlife - (birds, deer, turkey, etc) (no domestic animals)
5. Entries must be postmarked or delivered to the office by October 24th at:

6. **A photographer can only win once in each category.**
No more than four entries per category.
7. A \$30 prize will be awarded for 1st place, \$20 for 2nd, and \$10 for 3rd, in each category.
8. Photos will not be returned unless accompanied by a separate self-address stamped envelope or can make arrangements to pick them up at the DCCD after October 31st.
9. The DCCD reserves the right to make and keep copies of any photo entries, and may use them in future promotional materials without any compensation.
10. DCCD reserves the right to display the winning photos.
11. Members of the Conservation Board, employees & immediate families, are not eligible.
12. The DCCD reserves the right to place photos in the appropriate category.
13. The DCCD reserves the right to make any and all decisions regarding interpretation of these rules.
