## Delaware County Park Conditions

Status after 7/23/10 floods in Delaware County

**Turtle Creek** – Maquoketa River boat ramp access is - **CLOSED**

**Silver Creek Wildlife Area** – Vehicle access - **NOT RECOMMENDED**

**Pioneer Road River Access** – **CLOSED**

**Baileys Ford** – All of the park campgrounds, shelters, and trout stream access – **OPEN**

Maquoketa River Canoe Access – **OPEN**

Maquoketa River Boat ramp usage has been changed and is limited to small light flat bottom boats, canoes, and inflatable watercraft due to very low water level – use extreme caution if attempting to launch a boat

**Fountain Springs** – walk in access is permitted - **OPEN**

**Coffins Grove** – campground and shelters – **OPEN**

**Twin Bridges** – campground and shelters – **OPEN**

**Hardscrabble Wildlife Area** – Vehicle Access - **OPEN**

**Turtle Creek** – campground and shelter - **OPEN**

**Plum Creek** – Shelter and park - **OPEN**

**Pin Oak** – Maquoketa River Canoe Access – **OPEN**

**Dundee Access** - Maquoketa River canoe access – **OPEN**

**Dunlap Park** – Maquoketa River canoe access and shelter – **OPEN**

**Delhi Dam River Access** – **OPEN**

**Retz Area** – Maquoketa River canoe access – **OPEN**

All other Delaware County Parks and Wildlife Areas continue to be - **OPEN**
